Scott Sloan is Laureate Professor and Director of the Australian Research Council (ARC) Centre of Excellence in Geotechnical Science and Engineering at the University of Newcastle, NSW, Australia. He is a Fellow of both the Australian Academy of Science and the Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering, and currently holds an ARC Laureate Fellowship. Scott is the recipient the Telford Medal and Telford Premium from the ICE and the Thomas A Middlebrooks Award from the ASCE. He is currently editor-in-chief of Computers and Geotechnics and serves on the editorial boards of 5 other international journals. He is the author of over 220 papers in geotechnical engineering and engages with industry through his role as a Visiting Senior Principal with Coffey Geotechnics.
