Bob Holtz, Ph.D., P.E., is Professor of Civil Engineering at the University of Washington in Seattle. He previously was on the faculty at Purdue University for 15 years, and he has worked for the California Dept. of Water Resources, Swedish Geotechnical Institute, NRC-Canada, as a consulting engineer in Chicago, France, and Italy. He is co-author or editor of 10 books and book chapters, including *An Introduction to Geotechnical Engineering* (with W. D. Kovacs, 1981), the *FHWA Geotextile Engineering Manual* (1985), *Geosynthetics for Soil Improvement* (ASCE 1988), *FHWA Geosynthetic Design and Construction Guidelines* (1989 and 1995), *Geosynthetic Engineering* (1997); and more than 180 technical papers, discussions, and reports.
